fourth for providing for the Establishment of Compositions for Tithes
in Ireland, in order to ascertain and fix a true and just Com-
position for all Tithes arising growing yielded and payable
within the part of the Parish of Abbey in the Union of
Athlone & County of Galway Do hereby Certify that the true
and just amount of all Tithes whatsoever within said part
of said Parish, pursuant to agreement made between the
Tithes Owner and the Parishioners, and persons paying
Tithes within such proportion of said Parish is sixty two
pounds five shillings and three pence & sterling payable half year-
ly from the first of November One thousand eight hundred and twenty
six by even parts on every first day of May and first day of November
in every year which sum of sixty two pounds five shillings and
three pence & sterling is due and payable to the Honble the Ven^{ble}
Archdeacon & C. P. French the Rector and his Successor in equal
proportions as aforesaid as a composition for all Tithes Criminally
by him as Rector of said Parish in said Union And We do further
Certify that the average price of Wheat being the Corn sown, par-
ticularly grown in that part of said County for the period of seven years
ending the first day of November One thousand eight hundred and
twenty one is One pound eighteen shillings and eight pence half penny
per barrel
