

We William Burke of Ballydugan and Pierce Blake of Hollypark County of Galway Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the reign of King George the fourth entitled An Act to provide for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time to ascertain and fix a true and just amount of composition for all Tithes whatsoever, arising growing or payable within the Parish of Abbeymorgan in the County of Galway do hereby certify that the true and just amount of composition for all Tithes whatsoever within the said Parish is Two Hundred and Thirty Seven Pounds Ster. by the year - of which sum of Two Hundred and Thirty Seven Pounds Ster. One Hundred and seventeen Pounds Ster. is due and payable to the Reverend Edward Hartigan as composition for all Tithes claimable by him as Rector and Vicar of of the said Parish of Abbeymorgan Fifty Five Pounds Ster. is due and payable to the Rev. Richard Byrne as Prebendary of Tinnee, Eleven Pounds Ster. is due and payable to the Rev. Alex. Macaulay as Prebendary of Kiltiskil Fifteen pounds Ster. is due and payable to the Venerable Archdeacon Bulson as Archdeacon of Clonsilla Five pounds Ster. is due and payable to the Rev. Mr. Hawkins as Dean of Clonsilla Nine pounds is due and payable to the Rev. Richard Vincent as Prebendary of Milquain and Twenty six Pounds Ster. is due and payable to the Bishop of the Diocese of Clonsilla.

And we do further certify that <sup>the</sup> average Price of oats being the Corn principally grown in such County for the Period of seven years ending on the first day of November 1821 (Twenty one) is Ten Shillings & Six pence by the barrel given under our hands and seals this thirty first day of October 1822.
