

To the Church Wardens of the Parish of Abbeyleix

Mr William Bell & Andrew Galbraith Com-
missioners duly appointed Viewers under the virtue of
an Act made in the fourth Year of the Reign of
King George the fourth entitled an Act to provide
for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in
Ireland for a limited time to ascertain & fix a
true & just composition for all Tithes arising & remain-
ing due & payable within the Parish of Abbeyleix
in the County of Wick do hereby certify that the
true & just amount of Composition for all Tithes
whatsoever within the said Parish is Five hundred
& thirty Pounds by the Year. Of which sum of
five hundred & thirty Pounds two third parts are
due & payable to the Right Hon. John Lord Viscount
DeVere as a composition for the Tithes claimable
by him as Lay Proprietor & one third part is
due & payable to the Hon. & Rev. Father Vicar the
Vicar. And we do further certify that the
average price of Tithes being the Corn principally
grown in such County for the period of seven
Years ending on the first day of November 1825
is fiftieth Shillings & two pence for every Acre.
