To ALL whom these Presents shall come, I

Richard St George
Incumbent of the Parish of *Lisshing and Abbeyshrule*
in the County of Longford send Greeting, WHEREAS, *John M. Robinson Esq*
in the County of *Longford* has truly served me with a Notice in Writing, in
the Words and Figures following,

SIR,—You are hereby required to take Notice, that in pursuance of an Act passed in the
second and third year of his present Majesty, entitled, an Act to amend three Acts passed respec-
tively in the fourth, fifth, and in the seventh and eighth years of the Reign of his late Majesty,
King George the Fourth, providing for establishing of COMPOSITION of TITHES in Ireland,
and to make such Compositions permanent, I

of *Down Hall*
in the County of *Down*
who being seized in fee simple of All That and Those, the
lands of Abbeyshrule, Lisshing, Druminnis, Ballynaghy and Rathcollagh
in the parish of Abbeyshrule and also the lands of Inghafinn, Dany,
Ingharinnagh and Coonies in the parish of Lisshing except that part
of the lands of Druminnis held by the representatives of the heirs
of the Rev Edward Coates and that part of the lands of Coonies held
by the representatives or under tenants of (David Brown Esq)

situate in the Parish of *Lisshing & Abbeyshrule* Barony of *Abbeyshrule* and
County of *Longford* or otherwise entitled, according to the Provisions of said
Act, to agree for and undertake the Payment of the Composition for Tithes lawfully payable for
and in respect of such Lands, do hereby signify to you my desire to agree for and undertake the
Payment of such Composition as aforesaid, for and in respect of the said Lands, and I hereby re-
quire you to grant me a Certificate in Writing, conformable to the Provisions of said Act, declaring
me entitled to the benefit of this Notice, and to perform the other matters on your part required
by the said Act to be done.
