It has been notified to us
that the Prebend of ~~St. Mary~~ in the Cathedral
Church of Saint Mary's in the Diocese
of Down is now vacant by the death of the
Honble and venerable Charles ~~John~~ French and
it appears that the crops and revenues of
the said Prebend consist exclusively of portions
of the Rectorial Tithes of the Parish of
Kilmara Berrichole & Kilmacassar in said
Diocese, that is to say of a portion of the
Rectorial Tithes of the Parish of Kilmara amounting
to Thirtyone Pounds ten Shillings per annum, of a
portion of the Rectorial Tithes of the Parish of
Berrichole amounting to Thirtyone Pounds ten
Shillings per annum, and of a portion of the
Rectorial Tithes of the Parish of Kilmacassar
amounting to Thirtyone pounds per annum,
and it appears also that there is no cure of
souls in the said Prebend, or annexed to such Rectorial
Tithes or any of them And whereas the Parish
or Rectory and Vicarage of ~~St. Mary~~ Hill with
