of Achary pursuant to the 4th and 5th of George the Fourth Entitled "Acts for
providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland." It is agreed
on the proposal of Denis O'Connor Esq^{re} and seconded by James Irwin Esq^{re} That
John Armstrong Esq^{re} be appointed Chairman

Resolved that it is agreed on this Day that the Sum of Seven Hundred Pounds be
given yearly for the term of Twenty five years to come under the above already mentioned
Acts for the Bishop of Achary namely the Dominions of Malinbeg and Glenties
and being and agreed to by the Bishop and Dean Blakely

Resolved that John Armstrong Esq^{re} is appointed Commissioner on behalf of the Bishop
and that John Gray of Cottage is appointed by the Very Reverend Dean Blakely
