We, William Rose and John Christy Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the fourth year of the reign of King George the fourth Intituled "an act to provide for the Establishment of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time" to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all Tithes arising growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of Kelare in the County of Dumrick, do hereby certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish of Kelare is Eight hundred and eight pounds fourteen shillings and five pence by the Year of which sum of Eight hundred and eight pounds fourteen shillings and five pence, Five hundred and six pounds seventeen shillings and six pence are due and payable to the R^t Hon^{ble} Earl of Dumraven as a composition for the Tithes claimable by him as owner of the Rectorial Tithes and Thun being one pound and one pound sixteen shillings eleven pence are due and payable to the Rev^d Edward Croker as owner of the Vicarial Tithes of P. Parish
