Kellus commissarius duly appointed and sworn under
and by virtue of an act made in the fourth year of the Reign
of King George the fourth entitled an act to provide for
the establishing of compositions for tithes in Ireland for
a limited time, and of an act made in the fifth year
of the Reign of King George the fourth entitled an act
to amend an act of the last Session of Parliament, for pro-
viding for the establishing of composition for tithes in
Ireland to ascertain and fix a true and just composition
for all tithes arising, growing, yielded, or payable within
the Parish of Agba in the County of Carlow, do hereby
certify that the true and just amount of composition
for all Impropriate tithes within the said Parish is
Three Hundred Pounds sterling by the year, of which
Sum of Three Hundred Pounds one half or moiety is due
and payable to the Rev. Mr. John Molony as a com-
position for the tithes claimable by him as Lessee of the
Rev. Arthur Jocelyn Molony Impropriator, for one moiety
of said Impropriate tithes during the term that said
Lease shall continue, and after the expiration of said
Lease, to the said Arthur Jocelyn Molony Impropriator his
heirs or assigns, and one other moiety of which is due and
payable to Mr. William Driscoll as a composition for the
tithes claimable by him as tenant to the said Arthur
