We Peter Roe and Thomas White Commissioners
duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an
Act made in the fourth year of the Reign of King
George the fourth intitled an Act to provide for the
establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for
a limited time and of another Act, made in the
fifth year of the Reign of King George the fourth
intitled an Act to amend an Act of the last Session
of Parliament for providing for the establishing of
Compositions for Tithes in Ireland to ascertain and
fix a true and just Composition for all Rectorial
Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within
the parish of Agharoe in the County of Down do
hereby Certify that the true and just amount of
Composition for all the said Rectorial Tithes
whatever within the said parish, is, Five Hun-
dred and Twenty six Pounds three shillings and
one half penny Sterling British Currency by
the year, which Sum of Five hundred
and twenty six pounds three shillings and
one half penny is due and payable to the Hon^{ble}
and Rev^d Joseph Bourke as a Composition
for the Rectorial Tithes claimable by him as
Rector of the said Parish of Agharoe

And we do further Certify that the average
price of wheat being the Corn principally grown
in said County for the period of seven years ending
the first day of November one Thousand Eight Hundred
and twenty one is Twenty shillings per Barrel
