Certificate of Composition

We Peter Roe and Thomas White Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the Fourth year of the Reign of King George the Fourth entitled an Act to provide for the establishment of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time" and of another Act made in the fifth year of King George the Fourth entitled an Act to amend an Act of the last Session of Parliament for providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland" to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Vicarial Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Aghaboe in the Queen's County do hereby Certify that the ^{true} and just amount of Composition for all the said Vicarial Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Two hundred and sixty three pounds one shilling and six pence half penny Sterling British Currency by the Year which Sum of Two hundred and sixty three pounds one Shilling and six pence half penny is due and payable to the Rev^d Thomas Carr as a Composition for the Vicarial Tithes claimable by him as Vicar of the said Parish of Aghaboe.

And we do further Certify that the average price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in said County for the period of Seven years ending the first day of November one Thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty one is Twenty Shillings per Barrel
