Do hereby certify that at a Meeting held this
day in the Parish Church of Colpe for the Corporation
of Ireland for the County of Monmouth

That a Composition was agreed to for
the sum of Thirty Pounds by the year between the
Parishioners and the Lay Impropriators of said Parish
of Monmouth for all tithes one half to be paid to
Mrs Dutton Colhard by the other half to the Rev
John Magee - dated Colpe Mass 1st day of August
