and payable to the Impropriate Rector of the parish
as a Composition for Tithes claimable by him as Rector
of the said parish and the sum of Three hundred &
Sixty pounds being the other half is due & payable
to the Reverend Christopher Robinson the Vicar of the
said parish and we do hereby further certify that the
average price of oats being the Corn principally
