for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time" to ascertain and fix
a true and just Composition for All Tithes arising, growing,
yielded or payable within the Parish of Modeshil in the
Diocese of Cashel and County of Tipperary, Do hereby Certify,
that the true and just Amount of Composition for All Tithes
whatever within the said Parish is the Sum of Two Hundred
and Sixty Pounds Sterling by the Year; Which Sum of Two
Hundred and Sixty Pounds is due and payable to the Venerable
Henry Cotton, Archdeacon of Cashel, as a Composition for the
Tithe claimable by him as Rector and Vicar of the said Parish
of Modeshil

And We do further Certify, that the Average price of Wheat
being the Corn principally grown in such County, for the period
of Seven Years, ending on the First day of November 1821, is
according to a Schedule thereof furnished by the Right Hon^{ble}
Henry Goulbourn late Chief Sec^y to the Lord Lieutenant of Ireland
one Pound Eighteen Shillings & Eight Pence halppenny late Currency, or
one Pound Fifteen Shillings & Eight pence Three farthings British per Barrel
