

We Robert Donnell of Cole House in the County of Cork and Patrick Lawlor
of Mountmuck in the County of Cork Esquires, Commissioners duly appointed and
Sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the fourth year of the Reign of King
George the fourth entitled an act to provide for the Establishment of
Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time, to Ascertain and fix a true
and just Composition for all Tithes arising growing payable or payable within the
Parish of Imogula Diocese of Cloyne and County of Cork. Do hereby Certify
that the true and just Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever within the
Said Parish is Seven Hundred and Eighty Pounds starting by the year
of which sum of Seven Hundred and Eighty Pounds, Three Hundred and
Ninety Pounds are due and Payable to the Rev. George Smith as a
Composition for the Tithe claimable by him as Vicar of Said Parish
and Three Hundred and Ninety Pounds of Said sum of Seven Hundred and
Eighty Pounds, are due and payable to Roger G Davis Esq: as
of Said Parish

And we do further Certify the average price of Oats being
the Corn principally grown in such County for the Period of Seven Years
Ending on the first day of November 1821 is fourteen Shillings and One
penny by the Barrel

of which the foregoing is a Copy, and we do further Consent on behalf of
Such Owners and Occupiers of Land that the Said Composition shall be
Invariable for Twentyone years from the first day of November next, and shall
