

 position for all Tythes whatever within the
 said Parish is One Hundred and fifty
 pounds by the Year payable to the Rev:
 Robt. Mitchell Kennedy Rector and Vicar of
 said Parish, And we do further
 Certify that the Average price of oats
 being the corn principally grown in such
 County for the period of seven years
 ending on the 1st day of November 1821.
 is Fifteen Shillings and Two pence
 and farthing
