 for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded,  
 & payable within the parish of Aghincor  
 in the Kings County, do hereby certify  
 that the true and just amount of  
 composition for all Tithes whatever  
 within the said parish is one  
 Hundred and Fifty pounds by the  
 year payable to Messrs Robt  
 Mitchell Kennedy Rector & Vicar  
 of said parish -

And we do further certify that the  
 average price of oats being the  
 corn principally grown in such County  
 for the period of seven years ending  
 on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of November 1821 is  
 Fifteen shillings and two pence or  
 farthing,
