

Fithe Composition

Silvester Rait having been duly appointed and sworn
"Commissioner under and by Virtue of an Act made in the
fourth Year of the Reign of King George the Fourth entitled
an Act to provide for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes
in Ireland for a limited time, and by Virtue of an Act passed
in the Second and third Years of the Reign of His Majesty
King William the Fourth entitled an Act to amend
three Acts passed respectively in the fourth fifth, and in
the Seventh, and eighth Years, of the Reign of His late Majesty
King George the Fourth, providing for the establishing of Compositions
for Tithes in Ireland and to make such Composition perm-
-anent, and to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition
for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded, or payable within the
Parish of Arkhill in the County of Wicklow. Do
hereby Certify that the true and just amount of Compos-
-ition for all Tithes whatever within the Said Parish is
One hundred and sixty eight Pounds seventeen
Shillings and five pence halfpenny by
by the year, of which Sum Fifty six Pounds
five Shillings and nine pence three
farthings Sty. or one third, are due and payable to
the Rev^d Charles Palmer as a Compositor for the Tithe claimable
by him as Owner of the Vicarial Tithe and that two thirds
