Pounds by the Year, the whole of which Sum
is due and payable to the Rev: Geo Praboran
as a Composition for the Tithes Claimable by
him as Rector Incumbent of said parish to
remain invariable for the term of twenty one Years
from the first day of May next One thousand
Eight hundred and twenty five, using the rate
 thereof, and we further certify that the average
price of Oats being the Corn principally grown
in such County for the period of seven Years ending
on the first day of Nov: One thousand eight hundred
and twenty one is fifteen Shillings and two pence
