Parish to remain invariable for the term of twenty one
Years from the first day of May next
one thousand eight hundred and twenty five,
ensuing the date hereof, and we further Certify
that the average price of Oats being the Corn
principally grown in such County for the period
of seven Years ending on the first day of Novr
one thousand eight hundred and twenty one is
fifteen Shillings and two pence fastening the
