We have called before us and examined upon Oath the Incumbent and the several Occupiers of land in the Parish of Ardmore, and have examined other Persons who could give us general information to enable us to ascertain the several quantities of land in the possession of each occupier therein, and the taxable value of such land in the said Parish. — To save expense to the Occupier of land in the Parish, which a General Survey thereof would necessarily induce, we have required from each occupier the Production of that Lease, Will or Contract under which he or she occupies his or her holding therein, and all Maps, Surveys, Plans, Estimates or Calculations in the custody, possession or power of such occupier, and we have inspected and minutely examined the same, and have given some in every instance date, authority, and authenticity, whereby we have been enabled to ascertain the size or quantum of the several distinct grants of land in said Parish in the possession of each occupier of land therein. — We have further caused to be surveyed in each holding such parts thereof as are described to be waste lands by the Statute, and we have ascertained the gross quantity in each holding, whereby we have accurately ascertained the Real or Net quantity of arable and pasture land in the possession of each Occupier therein. — And we find that the said Net quantity of arable and pasture land in said Parish subject to the payment of the imposts per Acre is two thousand and fifty seven acres and nineteen pence and six farthings per acre, to be all of it arable, and that the sum to be collected and applied on the said parish of Ardmore is two hundred and seventy five pounds Sterling yearly, the whole of which is payable to the Reverend George Brabazon as the present Rector Incumbent thereof.

We have divided the several lands in said Parish into six distinct Classes. —
 The first Class is to pay three Shillings and one penny thirteen halfpennies per acre.
 The second Class is to pay three Shillings per acre.
 The third Class — two Shillings and one penny halfpenny per acre.
 The fourth Class — two Shillings and three pence three farthings per acre.
 The fifth Class — one Shilling and one penny one eighth per acre.
 The sixth Class — One Shilling and ten pence halfpenny per acre.
 As the sum is fully set forth in the Subjoined Book or Schedule thereto.
