It is hereby agreed on by the Rev. Henry Lambert
Bayly Rector of the Parish of Ardcloy in the Diocese of
Dublin and County of Wicklow and by Messrs. Howell &
Johnson Improvitors entitled to one half of Corn Tithes of
said Parish and by a Special Vestry duly held for said Parish
pursuant to the provisions of the 4 George 4 Chap 99 entitled
an Act for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland
for a limited time that the sum of Three Hundred and Six
Pounds Sterl as the Annual Sum Composition under the
said Act for all the Tithes payable out of said Parish of
Ardcloy in the following proportions namely to the aforesaid
Rev. Hen. L. Bayly the sum of Two hundred and Fifty Pounds
and to the aforesaid Messrs. Howell & Johnson the sum
of Fifty Six Pounds
