

Whereas The Honorable Granville Lension Proby
as Committee of the Earl of Carysfort has served upon
and given to me a notice in writing under his
hand bearing date Arklow October the 9th 1834
whereby he notifies to me that he is desirous of
agreeing for and undertaking the future payment
of the Composition for Tithe as appotted under the
4th Geo: 4th Cap 99 for the whole of the Parish of
Arklow, that is situated in the County of Wicklow
(with the exception of that part known by the name
of the Abbey Lands) all which Lands belong to the
Earl of Carysfort by virtue of a fee farm Lease from
the Duke of Ormonde - Now I do hereby Certify &
declare that the said Earl of Carysfort on whose
behalf the said Honorable ^{Lension} Proby has served
me with Notice is entitled to the benefit thereof

of October 1834

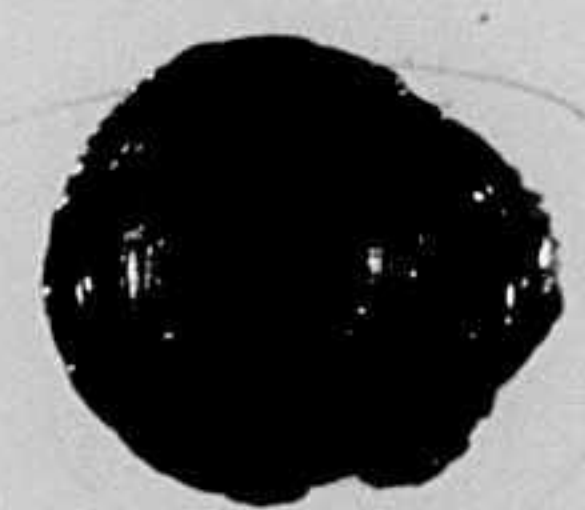
