as Committee of the Earl of Carysfort has served
upon and given to me a notice in writing under
his hand bearing date Arklow October the 9th
1834 whereby he notifies to me that he is
desirous of agreeing for and undertaking
the future payment of the composition for
tithe as appotted under the 14th of Geo. 4th
Cap. 99. payable out of the Parish of Kilkahurlee
So far as respects the one third of that Composition
of which I am owner the whole of that Parish
belonging to the Earl of Carysfort by virtue
of a fee farm Lease from the Duke of Ormond
Now I do hereby certify and declare that the said
Earl of Carysfort on whose behalf the 1st Honble
Granville Levison Proby has served me with notice
is entitled to the benefit thereof
