We Richard Waddy Edge and Samuel Alkin Commissioners duly
Appointed and sworn under and by Virtue of an Act made in the fourth
Year of the Reign of King George the Fourth intituled "An Act to provide
for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited
Time" to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes
arising, growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of Artrament in
the County of Wexford, do hereby certify that the sum of Two Hundred
Pounds by the Year has been fixed and agreed upon by and between the
Reverend Frederick Draffen Ecclesiastical Incumbent, and a special
Vestry duly assembled for said Parish pursuant and by Virtue of the Provi-
sions contained in an Act made in the fifth year of the Reign of King
George the Fourth intituled "An Act to amend an Act of the last Session
of Parliament for providing for the establishing of Compositions for
Tithes in Ireland" as the amount of Composition for all Tithes
whatsoever within the said Parish invariable for and during the Term
of Twenty one years from the first day of November next, that the
said agreement so made for the sum of Two Hundred Pounds by the
Year has received the Consent and Approbation of the Right Reverend
Thomas Stringer D.D. Lord Bishop of Loughlin and Ferns as Bishop
of the Diocess of Ferns wherein the said Parish is situate and Patron
of the said Parish (pursuant to the last herein mentioned Act) and
