

We Thomas Lancaster of Fort William in the County of Roscommon and
 Walter Lambert Jr of Saint Elens in the County of Galway Esq^{rs} duly appointed
 and sworn as Commissioners under and by Virtue of an Act of Parliament
 made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the Fourth intituled an act
 to provide for the Establishment of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited
 time, and another act made to amend said Act, in the fifth year of the Reign of
 King George the Fourth, for providing for the Establishment of Compositions for Tithes
 in Ireland, in order to ascertain, and fix a true and just Composition for all
 Tithes arising, growing, yielded and payable within the Parish of Abbert
 in the Union of Athlenny, Arch. Diocese of Tuam and County of Galway
 Do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of all Tithes whatsoever
 within the said Parish, pursuant to agreement between the Tithe Owners
 and the Parishioners and persons paying Tithes in said Parish is three hundred
 and forty five pounds eighteen shillings and ten pence to wit, payable half yearly
 from the first day of November One thousand eight hundred and twenty six
 by equal Gales on every first day of May and first day of November in every
 year, of which sum three hundred and thirty eight pounds eight shillings and ten
 pence to wit, is due and payable to the Hon^{ble} the Ven^{able} Archdeacon
 C. Le P. French the Rector & his successor in equal proportions as aforesaid, as a
 Composition for Tithes Claimable by him as Rector of said Parish, and seven pounds
 ten shillings Sterling the Remainder is due and payable to the Rev. Henry Murry
 as Prebendary of Tyraxon in equal proportions as aforesaid as a Composition for
 Tithes Claimable by him as such Prebendary in said Parish, And We do
 further Certify that the average price of Wheat being the Corn principally
 grown in that part of said County for the period of seven years ending the
 first day of November One thousand eight hundred and twenty one is one
 pound eighteen shillings and eight pence half penny per Bushell. -
 Given under our Hands this sixth - day of August 1827 years
