

*Certificate of the Commissioners*  
appointed under and by virtue of the Tithe Composition  
Act, for the consolidated Union of Athlery and the  
Chapleraries of Abbert and Derymacloghry

We Walter Lambert and Thomas Lancaster Esq<sup>rs</sup>  
Commissioners duly appointed and Sworn under and by  
virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the Reign of  
King George the fourth intituled an Act to provide for the  
establishment of Composition of Tithes in Ireland for  
a limited time, to ascertain and fix a true and just  
composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded or  
payable, within the Parish of Athlery aforesaid in the  
County of Galway, do hereby Certify that the true and just  
amount of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever within the  
said Parish is One thousand and seventy five Pounds Sterling  
by the Year, of which sum of One thousand and seventy five  
Pounds One thousand and sixty seven Pounds ten shillings  
are payable to the Hon<sup>ble</sup> and Venerable Charles Le Poer French  
D.D. as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector  
of said Parish and seven Pounds ten shillings are due and  
payable to the Reverend Henry Murray D.D. as Rectorary  
of Tysaxon to be levied from the town lands of Tysaxon which  
sum is to be invariable for the term of twenty one years from  
the first day of November next.
