Certificate of composition for the parish of Athleague
The undersigned Henry Kelly and Arthur Browne Comrs.
of the said parish duly appointed and sworn under and by
virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the reign
of King George the fourth intitled an Act to provide
for the composition for Tithes in Ireland for a limited
term frisco: "to ascertain and fix a true and just
composition for all Tithes arising from any
fields or pastures within the parish of Athleague
in the Counties of Galway and Roscommon do here
by certify that the true and just amount of composi-
tion for all Tithes whatever within the said parish
is Two hundred and forty five pounds by the
year: of which sum of Two hundred and forty five
pounds three parts being one hundred
and forty seven pounds are due and pay-
able to the Rev James Gaugon as a Corporation
for the Tithes claimable by him as Vicar of the
said parish: and two parts being one hundred
and forty seven pounds are due and payable to the In-
corporated Society for Promoting English Protestant
Schools in Ireland as owners of the Rectorial Tithes
thereof - And we do further certify that the average
price of oats being that one principally grown in
such Counties for the period of seven years ending
on the first day of November one thousand eight
hundred and twenty one is two Shillings and six
pence by the Bushel
