an act to provide for the establishing of Compo-
sitions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time to
ascertain here a true and just Composition for
all Tithes arising growing, Yelded a pay^{ment}
within the Parish of Balfoghnan Union of
Keadinstown, in the County of Meath do
hereby Certify that the true and just amount
of Composition for all Tithes whatsover within
the said parish is Twenty five pounds by the
Year which sum of £25 is due and payable
to the Revd Dawson by Paulohury as a ^{Yearly} Composition
for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector of B. parish
And We do further Certify that the average
price of wheat being the Com principally
grown in such County for the period of seven Years
ending on the 1st November 1821 is One pound
Eighteen Shillings & Eight pence halpenny per barrel
