duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act
made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the
Fourth Intituled an Act to provide for the establishing
of Composition for Tythes in Ireland for a limited time
to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for
all Tythes Arising Growing, Yielded, or payable within
+ the Parish of Ballyracon in the County of Wicklow do
hereby Certify that the true and just amount of composition
for all Tythes whatever within the said Parish is One
Hundred and Twelve Pounds Ten Shillings and eight
pence halfpenny by the year Of which sum of One
Hundred and Twelve pounds Ten Shillings and eight pence
halfpenny, One Hundred and four pounds two Shillings & five
pence is the average of the Tythe of said Parish according
to the Statute, and the remainder being the sum of Eight
Pounds Eight Shillings & three pence halfpenny -
We add in consideration of the Tythe of said Parish
being let at a moderate rate which sum of One
Hundred and Twelve pounds ten Shillings & eight pence
halfpenny by the year is due and payable to the
Rev^d Richard Pawell as a composition for the Tythe
claimable by him as Vicar of said Parish
And we do further certify that the average
price of Oats being the Corn principally
grown in such County for the Period of seven
years ending on the first day of November
1821 is fifteen Shillings & 2/4 of Barrell
