time to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all
Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of
Sheffin or Balleen in the Diocese of Down and County of Wickham
hereby certify that the true and just amount of Composition for the
Vicarial Tithes and also for the Rectorial Tithes of said Parish is
Two hundred Pounds Sterling of British Currency by the Year and is
due and payable to the Rev. Luke Fowler as a composition for the
Tithes claimable by him as Vicar and also as Rector of the Rectorial Church
of the said Parish and that the agreement shall be in force for the
Term of Twenty one Years from the first day of November
1827 seven. Subject to Variation every seven Years
And we do further certify that the average
price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in such
Parish for the period of seven Years ending the first day of
November 1821 was one Pound Eighteen Shillings and
Eight pence half penny per Barrel late Irish Currency
dated this first Day of June 1827 seven
