both in the County of Wickhamy Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under  
and by Virtue of an Act made in the 11th year of the Reign of King George the 3rd  
Entituled an Act to provide for the establishment of Composition for Tithes in the  
land for a limited time have certain and fix a true and just composition for  
all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Coolcashin  
in the Diocese of Ferns and County of Wickhamy do hereby certify that the true  
and just amount of composition for the Vicarial Tithe and also for the Ric-  
torial Tithe of said Parish is one Hundred and sixty four Pounds and ten  
pence half penny 1/2 of British currency by the Year and is due and payable  
by the Reverend Luke Fowler as a composition for the Tithe claimable by him as  
Vicar and also as Vicar of the Ricorial Tithe of said Parish and the Deacons  
of the Church of St. Canice as Rectors of said Parish and that the agreement  
shall be in force for the term of Twenty one Years from the first Day of  
November 1827 seven Subject to Variation every Seven Years And we do  
further certify that average price of Wheat being the Corn principally  
grown in such County for the period of Seven Years ending the first Day  
of November 1821 one is one Pound Eighteen Shillings and Eight pence  
half penny 1/2 Barrel late Irish Currency Dated the first Day of June  
1827 seven
