Whereas

due notices having been first affixed at
the times and in the manner directed
by the statutes in such case made and
provided by Thomas Fuller George Lucas and Robert Heard three
Owners of land in the Parish of Ballinacree in the Division of
Bandon and Cork County West Riding each charged with the
annual payment of the sum of Three pounds and upwards in respect
of the rent charge payable in lieu of the Composition for tithes within
said Parish made by the Certificate of William Orr and William
Hamick bearing date the third day of November one thousand
eight hundred and twenty five in pursuance of the statutes in such
case made and provided and whereby the gross amount of Composition
for all tithes whatever in said Parish was certified to be the annual
sum of six hundred and thirty pounds they the said three Owners of
land made application in writing to the Justices of the Peace at the
Quarter Sessions above mentioned to have the average price of wheat
being the grain in said Certificate mentioned for the seven years last
preceding inquired of and ascertained in order that the said Composition
for tithes in said Parish and the tithe rent charge payable in lieu
thereof might be diminished in proportion to such average price as
compared with the price stated in the said Certificate namely One
pound eighteen shillings of the late Irish Currency per barrel being
equivalent to One pound fifteen shillings and one penny of the present
Currency
