owner of the Rectorial Duties of said Parish.

And we do further certify that the average
price of oats being the Corn principally grown
in said County for the period of seven Years ending
on the first Day of November 1824 is fifteen
shillings & two pence farthing p^r. Bushell
Date this 31st Day of October 1825
