eight pounds sixteen shillings & six pence
sum of four hundred & ninety eight pounds six-
teen shillings the same is due & payable to the
Rt Hon^{ble} & Rev^d the Lord Mandon the Rector
owner of the Rectorial Vicarage of the Parish

and we further certify that the average price of
Oats being the Corn principally grown in the County
for the period of seven years ending on the 1st Day
of November 1821 is fifteen shillings & two pence
per barrel for the Parish of Mallyeslane.
