whate'er within the said Parish, is Forty
pounds by the year, as agreed on between
the Incumbent and Parishioners under the
27th sect. of said act, which are due and payable
to the Rev. Anthony Thomas as Rector and Vicar
of said Parish - And we do further Certify
that the average price of oats being the corn prin-
cipally grown in such County in the period
of seven years ending on 30 Decr. 1830 is Ten-
shillings per barrel -
