in said Certificate and whereas the said Reverend George Stone having appeared in support of his said application by his agent and attorney, and Mr George Fraser attorney having appeared on behalf of John Frank's Esq, and Mr ~~John~~ Patrick ^{James} Murphy attorney having appeared for David Vandeleur Roche Esq being two of the Parishioners of the said Parish and the said Notice of Application, Certificate and that the said George Stone was entitled to the Rent ~~charge~~ in lieu of Tithes Composition, as such Renter in said Parish and the average price of oats, as ascertained in the Public Gazette for the seven years preceding having been proved Now the said Justices do ascertain from the said Gazette that the average price of oats for the said period of seven years is thirteen shillings and eight pence Sterling per barrel, and the said Justices do accordingly order and adjudge that the amount of the said Composition for tithes in said Parish of Ballingarry and the rent charge payable in lieu thereof shall be increased in proportion to the difference between the said average price of thirteen shillings and eight pence per barrel for the said period of seven years and the average price aforesaid and set forth in the said Certificate of Composition and that the apportionment of such Composition shall be amended accordingly.
