We John S. Brown, jr. and Michael Lynch  
Commissioners duly appointed and sworn  
under and by virtue of an act passed in the  
fourth year of the reign of King George the  
fourth entitled an Act to provide for the  
establishing of Compositions for Tithes in  
Ireland for a limited time. Do certify that  
at a vestry duly held on the 24th. day of July  
in the year one thousand eight hundred  
and twenty-six in the parish church of  
Ballingarry in the County of and Diocese of  
Limerick for the purpose of carrying  
the provisions of the above act into effect  
in said parish, it was agreed on by the  
Parishioners and accepted by the Vicar and  
Lay Impropriator that the sum of nine  
hundred pounds should be the Composition  
for the Vicarial & Rectorial Tithes of said  
parish by the year for the term of twenty-  
one years from the first day of November  
next.
