

By the Justices Assigned to keep  
the Peace in and for the County of Cork at a  
General Quarter Sessions of the Peace holden at  
Youghal in and for the Division of Middleton and  
County of Cork on the thirtieth day of June  
One thousand eight hundred and fifty four

Whereas due notice of application having been first affixed at the times  
and in the manner directed by the Statutes in such Case made and provided by  
The Most Noble The Marquis of Thomond, Mountfort Longfield, and  
Richard Sherlock, Esquires, three persons owners of Land in the Parish of  
Dallintemple otherwise Churchtown Diocese of Cloyne and County of Cork  
Division of Middleton and Cork County East Riding each Charged with the  
annual payment of the sum of Three pounds and upwards in respect of the  
Rent Charge payable in lieu of the Composition for tithes within said Parish  
made by the Certificate of Burton Philb's bearing date the Twelfth day of  
December One thousand eight hundred and thirty three and in pursuance of  
the Statute in such Case made and provided and Whereby the Gross  
amount of Composition for all tithes whatever in the said Parish was  
Certified to be the annual sum of Five hundred pounds five Shillings the  
said three Owners of Land made an application in Writing to the Justices of  
the Peace at the Quarter Sessions above mentioned to have the average price of  
Wheat being the Grain in the Certificate mentioned for the preceding seven  
years in the Statute in that behalf mentioned enquired of and ascertained in  
order that the said Composition for tithes and the Rent Charge in lieu of  
such Composition might be diminished according to such average price as  
Compared with the price of One pound twelve Shillings and one half penny  
being the price of Wheat as set forth in the said Certificate And  
Whereas the said Applicants and the Venerable William Gray  
Mansel the person Claiming to be entitled to said Rent Charges in said  
Parish having appeared before the said Justices at such Quarter Sessions by  
their Counsel or Agent and the said notice of application and Certificate  
having been proved And the said Justices having in pursuance of the  
Statute in that Case made and provided nominated and appointed James  
Richard Bull to be an Arbitrator to ascertain the average price of the  
Burrill of Good Marketable Wheat for the seven years preceding.  
And the said Justices having Caused the said Sessions of the Peace to  
be adjourned until the thirtieth day of October One thousand eight hundred  
and fifty four. And the said James Richard Bull having by his Report in  
Writing under his hand Certified to the said Justices at such adjournment that  
he had examined the Dublin Gazette and taken the average price of Wheat
