pound Six Shillings and Eleven pence for each Burrell of Twenty Stone, and it
appearing that the average price of Wheat being the Corn mentioned in
the said Certificate is less by more than one tenth than the average price set
forth in the said Certificate. NOW We the said Justices Do accordingly
Order and adjudge that the amount of said Composition for Tithes in said
Parish and the Rent Charge payable in lieu thereof shall be diminished in
proportion to the difference between the said average price of One pound
Six Shillings and Eleven pence for the said period of Seven years and the
average price stated in the said Certificate of Composition and that the
Applotment of such Composition should be amended accordingly. AND
the said Justices Do further order that the said reduction shall take effect
from the first day of May one thousand eight hundred and Fifty five
