<p>We Francis St Biddulph and John Luttrell Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made the fourth year of the Reign of his Majesty George the Fourth entitled "an Act to provide for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland," To ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Ballyadams and Ballintober in the Queens County - Do hereby certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is four hundred and seventy three pounds Ten Shillings and Seven Pence by the year, which sum is due and payable to the Rev^d Jeremy Marsh as Rector and Vicar of the said Parish - and do further Certify that the forgoing applotment contains our assessment and Valuation of the Tithes of said Parish and that the sums and charges attached to each persons name is just and true in every particular and this applotment and Valuation commenced on and from the first day of November 1824 - and and that the average price of Oats for the seven years previous to the year 1821 is fifteen Shillings and two pence.
