King George the fourth, entitled an Act to provide for the  
Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a  
limited time, to ascertain and fix a true and just compo-  
sition for all Tithes, arising growing & yielded, or payable  
within the Parish of Ballyadam & Ballytubrid in the  
Downs County do hereby certify that the true and just  
Amount of Composition for all Tithes, whatever, within the  
Said Parish, is Four hundred and Seventy three Pounds  
ten Shillings and seven pence Sterling, by the Year, which  
Sum is due and payable to the Rev James Marsh,  
as a Composition, for <sup>the</sup> Tithes claimable by him as Rector  
and Vicar of the Said Parish, and we do further certify the Average  
Price of Oats, being the Corn principally grown in Such  
County for the Period of Seven Years ending the first day of  
November 1721, is  $15 \frac{3}{4}$  per Barrel,
