In the matter of the composition for all Tithes and the Rent charge now payable in lieu thereof in the Parish of Ballycahill Division of Thurles in the County of Tipperary and in the matter of 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Victoria, Cap 109 and the statutes therein referred to and the 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> Victoria, Cap 57.

By the Justices of the Peace for the County of Tipperary assembled at the Quarter Sessions of the Peace held at Thurles in and for said County and Division on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of June 1896.

Whereas by certificate in writing made and dated the 14<sup>th</sup> day of November 1833 Robert Buchanan a commissioner duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of the several acts of Parliament providing for the establishment of composition for Tithes in Ireland to ascertain and fix a true and just composition
