

Now having heard the said applicants and their witnesses and having duly considered the several documentary proofs submitted to us on behalf of the said Lombe Athell, The Rev^d Garret Wall, Fitzgibbon Trant and Joseph Molloy in reference to their said application and the subject matter thereof including the Dublin Gazette for the seven years immediately preceding the said application and what was urged by the Counsel on behalf of the said applicants; we the said Justices do hereby declare that we have ascertained from the Dublin Gazettes the average price of wheat being the corn in the said certificate of the said Robert Buchanan mentioned for the seven years immediately preceding said application to us of said Lombe Athell, Rev^d Garret Wall, Fitzgibbon Trant and Joseph Molloy and we the said Justice do hereby find and adjudge that the average price of wheat as advertised in the Dublin Gazette for said period of

7 years was 17/6^d the barrel and we the said Justices do hereby adjudge and order that the amount of said composition for all Tithes in said Parish of Ballycabill and County of Tipperary due and payable to the Lay Impropriator thereof under and by virtue of said Original certificate and of the Rent Charge now payable to said Lay Impropriator in lieu thereof be varied and diminished for the seven years next ensuing the 1st day of November 1896, until such composition and rent charge in lieu thereof shall afterwards upon a like application be again varied and ascertained in pursuance of the provisions of the statutes in that behalf in such manner and to such extent that the amount of said composition and of said rent charge in lieu thereof shall bear the like proportion to the amount of the said Original composition as set forth in said Original certificate and due and payable to the Lay Impropriator and to the amount of the rent charge heretofore payable to
