Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue
of an act made in the Fourth Year of the Reign of King George
the Fourth intituled "An Act to provide for the establishing of
Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time to ascer-
tain and fix a true and just composition for all Tithes ~~arising~~
arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of
Kilgultane in the County of Cork We hereby certify
that the true and just amount of Composition for all the Lay
Impropriate Tithes whatever within that part of said Parish
consisting of that Portion of Land commonly called and
known by the Lands of Cloughleiffin is Eight Pounds and
four pence by the Year and which sum of Eight Pounds
and four pence by the Year is due and payable to Robert
Bayler as a composition for the Tithes claimable by him
as Owner of the Lay Impropriate Tithes of said Parish

AND we do further certify that the average Price
of Oats being the Grain principally grown in the County of
Cork for the period of seven Years ending on the First of
November One Thousand Eight hundred and Twenty one
is Fifteen Shillings and two pence per Barrel
