

I William Jones duly sworn under and by  
virtue of an act passed in the fourth year of  
the King of King George the fourth entitled  
an act to provide for establishing of composition  
for tithes in Ireland to ascertain and fix a true  
and just composition for all tithes arising growing  
yielded or payable within the parish of Ballydoon  
in the county of Cork do hereby certify that the true  
and just amount of composition for all tithes  
whatsoever within said parish of Ballydoon is  
one hundred and seventy seven pounds ten shillings  
sterling by the year are due and payable to the  
Reverend Archdeacon St Lawrence as Rector of the  
said Parish and that the average price of wheat  
(being the grain principally grown in this county)  
for the period of seven years ending the first  
day of November 1830 is one pound twelve shillings  
and one half penny Given under my hand this 8<sup>th</sup>  
day of November 1833 *Wm Jones*
