Whereas James Mous Sealy of Barleyfield in the County of Cork Esquire an Occupier or owner of the lands of Ballynoe in the Parish of Ballyhea in the Diocese of Cloyne and County of Cork finding himself aggrieved by the sum at which the said lands of Ballynoe in his possession had been appraised and apportioned by R. P. Mac Donnell Commissioner to appraise and apportion the tithes of the Parish of Ballyhea in the Diocese of Cloyne and County of Cork as compared with the rate or amount payable in respect of all other the lands in the said parish appealed to the Justices at this present Sessions of the Peace being the Sessions next but one after the Completion of said apportionment to wit the twenty ninth day of October 1834
