three Acts passed respectively in the fourth, fifth
and seventh years of the Reign of his late Majesty
King George the fourth, providing for the establishing
of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such
Compositions permanent; to ascertain and fix a true
and just Composition for all Tithes arising, grow-
ing, yielded or payable within the Parish of Ballyhay
in the County of Cork, do hereby certify that the
true and just amount of Composition for all
Tithes whatever within the said Parish, is Four
Hundred Pounds Sterling, by the year, which
sum of four Hundred Pounds, is due and payable
to the Reverend William Dunne, the Rector of the
said Parish of Ballyhay, as a Composition of
the Tithes claimable by him -

And I do further certify, that the
Average price of wheat being the Corn principally
grown in said County, for the period of seven years
ending on the 1st day of November 1830, is one
pound twelve Shillings and our halfpenny
Sterling per Barrel -

and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever
within the said Parish is four hundred pounds Sterling
by the year which sum of four hundred pounds is
due and payable to the Reverend William Dunne the
Rector of the said Parish of Ballyhay, as a composition
of the Tithes claimable by him And I do further
certify that the average price of wheat being the
corn principally grown in said County for the
period of seven years ending on the 1st day of
November 1830 is one pound twelve Shillings
and our halfpenny Sterling per barrel -
