The Right Reverend Father of the City of Waterford by and  
 John Barron of Ballinacorney in the County of Kilkenny  
 Esq. Commissioner duly appointed and sworn under  
 and by virtue of an Act made "the fourth year of  
 King George the fourth" entitled an Act  
 "to provide for the establishing of Compositions for  
 tithes in Ireland for a limited time" to ascertain  
 and lay a true and Just Composition for all  
 tithes arising, growing, yielding or payable  
 within the Parish of Dalry, parsonage and Vicarage of  
 Wickham as hereby Certify that the true and  
 Just amount of Composition for all tithes  
 whatever within the said Parish is one hundred  
 and sixty five Pounds by the year of which sum  
 the one third part being Fifty five Pounds are  
 due and payable to the Rev. Thomas Wallis  
 the Vicar of said Parish as a Composition for  
 the tithes chargeable by him and the sum of One  
 hundred and ten Pounds being the two thirds  
 of said one hundred and sixty five Pounds is due and  
 payable to Andrew Phelan of Dalrymanan  
 in the County of Kilkenny Farmer the  
 Agent of the Corporation of the City of  
 Waterford as a Composition for the tithes  
 chargeable by him Dated this 28<sup>th</sup> day of
