

The Ralph Henry and Thomas Hill (two witnesses duly attested
and sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the 14 year of
the reign of King George the fourth entitled "An Act for the
establishing of Compositions for tithes in Ireland for a limited
time" do certify that the true and just amount of
Composition for all tithes whatever within the Parish of Rals
Cloghmore as agreed upon at several vestry held for that purpose
is one hundred and ten pounds annually which sum
is due and payable to the Vicar and Curate of that
Parish as a composition for the tithes claimable by him
as Rector and Vicar of said Parish. And as do further
certify that the average price of Wheat being the most
principally grown in said County for the period of seven
years previous to and ending on the first of November 1824
is one pound eighteen shillings and eight pence
halfpenny sterling p. barrel
