Act made in the Fourth Year of the Reign of King  
George the Fourth Entitled an Act to provide for  
the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ire-  
land for a limited time, do Certify that the  
true and just Amount of Composition for all Tithes  
whatsoever within the Parish of Ballygibbon as agreed  
upon at a Special Vestry held for that purpose is  
One Hundred and ten Pounds Annually, which  
Sum is due and payable to the Hon<sup>ble</sup>. and Rev<sup>d</sup>.

able by him as Rector and Vicar of said Parish

And We do further Certify that the Average price  
of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in said  
County for the period of seven years, previous to  
and ending on the first of November 1823. is

One pound eighteen shillings and eight pence  
halfpenny p<sup>r</sup> Barrel. Aug. 10<sup>th</sup> 1824.
